{ Summer: Primates, Ecology & Conservation in Indonesia }

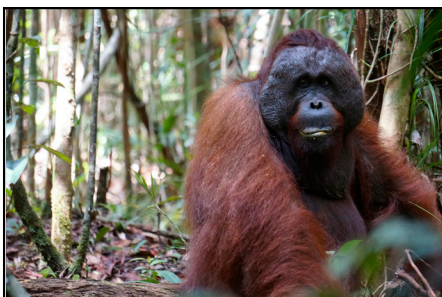

This program offers a unique opportunity for students to gain a hands-on immersive educational experience within Indonesia. Students can look forward to working alongside students and expert faculty from Universitas Nasional Jakarta. (UNAS.) The program will be conducted at 3 different sites:

Part 1: Halimun National Park in West Java

Students will focus on quantitative research methods and sustainable approaches to managing forests, agricultural areas, and aquatic ecosystems.



Part 2: Tuanan Biological Field Station in Borneo

Students will participate in the collection of behavioral data on wild orangutans, quantification of habitat characteristics, and the collection of biological samples.

Part 3: The Thousand Islands in the Java Sea

Students will have the opportunity to snorkel in one of the world's most diverse coral reef ecosystem and participate in a sea turtle release program.
